The advance public notice for the meeting was posted on three exit doors to the Courthouse and in the County Clerk's Office on April 6, 2023, at 9:00 A.M.

Matli made a motion to **amend then approve the agenda to include the adding of a Road Crossing permit to the unfinished business for District #3; adding the following to new business: request from the Hitchcock Fire Department; a Road Crossing permit for District #2; a burn ban for Blaine County.** Hicks seconded the motion. Voting aye were Matli, Hicks, and Schultz.

Matli made a motion to **approve the minutes from the April 3**, **2023 regular meeting**. Hicks seconded the motion. Voting aye were Matli, Hicks, and Schultz.

# UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

Matli made a motion to approve the renewal of road crossing permit for Rigid Oilfield Services located beginning at the SE/4 of Section 24 one line running for approximately 1.25 miles adjacent to the west side of N 2690 and ending at the SE/4 of Section 25, Township 16N, Range 10W-District #3. Schultz seconded the motion. Voting aye were Matli, Schultz, and Hicks.

# **NEW BUSINESS:**

Matli made a motion to approve the request from the Hitchcock Fire Department to purchase misc. equipment from Banner Fire Equipment, Inc. totaling \$2,975.00. Hicks seconded the motion. Voting aye were Matli, Hicks, and Schultz.

Schultz made a motion to approve the road crossing permit for Derby Exploration, LLC located commencing at Derby's Temanke well location in the southeast corner of Section 30, Township 18N, Range 13W, thence west in the north right-of-way of CR E 700 approximately 1/10 mile to an existing culver; thence south crossing under E 700 through the existing culvert to the south right-of-way of E 700; thence traveling west in the south right-of-way of E 700 to an existing culvert at the northwest corner of Section 31, Township 18N, Range 13W; thence north crossing under E 700 through the existing culvert to the east right-of-way for CR N 2450; thence north in the east right-of-way for N 2450 approximately 2/10 mile to an existing culvert; thence west through the existing culvert under N 240 to the west right-of-way for N 2450 lying in Dewey County; and thence south in the west right-of-way for N 2450 to its termination point at the southeast corner of Section 25, Township 18N, Range 14W, Dewey County-District #2. Hicks made a motion to approve the enacting of a burn ban for Blaine County for seven (7) days, to be revisited on a week to week basis and can be canceled at any time during a Commissioner meeting. Matli seconded the motion. Voting aye were Hicks, Matli, and Schultz.
