No bond or letter of credit is required by the Board this period.

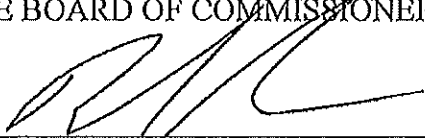
The Board of County Commissioners reserves the right to accept or reject any and all bids.
