MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BLAINE COUNTY, STATE OF OKLAHOMA, ON MARCH 28, 2016, IN WATONGA, OKLAHOMA.

The advance public notice for the meeting was posted on three exit doors to the Courthouse and in the County Clerk's Office on March 18, 2016, at 9:00 AM.

Allen made a motion to approve todays **Agenda**. Scheffler seconded the motion. Voting aye were Allen, Scheffler, and Cross.

Scheffler made a motion to approve the **minutes from the March 21, 2016 regular meeting.** Allen seconded the motion. Voting aye were Scheffler, Allen and Cross.

The Representatives from SWODA and the City of Weatherford visited with the Board about joining their association in regards to Blaine County's 911 operations. No action was taken.

Cross turned the floor over to Vicki Eggers and Jennifer Firgard with NODA. They explained the purpose of the hearing and the process of applying for grant funds through CDBG. They stated Blaine County is assisting the town of Hi8tchcock in applying for a CDBG Water/Wastewater Engineering Grant for a waterline replacement from the well to the town; the grant amount requested is \$242,000.00; the proposed CDBG activities are not likely to result in any residential displacement and the project will benefit low to moderate income leveled citizens.
