DEADLINE TO CHANGE PARTY AFFILIATION APPROACHES

Oklahomans who want to change their party affiliation must submit their change no later than March 31, Blaine County Election Board Secretary Brenda Rice said today. Voters may change their party affiliation online using the OK Voter Portal at <u>oklahoma.gov/elections/ovp</u> or by completing a new Voter Registration Application.

Brenda Rice reminds voters that no party changes are allowed from April 1 through August 31 during an even-numbered year.

"If we receive your request after March 31, we are required by law to hold that request and process it in September," Rice said.

Oklahoma has three recognized parties: Democratic, Republican, and Libertarian.

In Oklahoma, voters must be a registered member of a party in order to vote in that party's primary election. Independents are permitted to participate in a primary election, only if a party officially requests its elections be opened to Independent voters. Currently, only the Democratic Party allows Independents to vote in its primary elections.

All registered voters, regardless of political affiliation, can vote for any candidate during a General Election.

Applications are also available at the Blaine County Election Board located at 212 N Weigle Ave. Office hours are 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday through Friday.
