LAST WEEK TO REQUEST ABSENTEE BALLOTS FOR March 5 ELECTION

The deadline to request absentee ballots by mail is approaching. Applications must be received by the County Election Board no later than 5 p.m. Monday, February 19.

Blaine County Election Board Secretary Brenda Rice, said absentee voting is available to all voters and applications can be submitted several ways. "In Oklahoma, no excuse is needed to vote by absentee ballot, and it's easy to apply! Voters can submit their application online, in-person, by fax, mail, or even email," said Brenda Rice.

Voters can apply online using the OK Voter Portal at <u>oklahoma.gov/elections/ovp</u>. Applications are also available at the County Election Board or can be downloaded at <u>oklahoma.gov/elections</u>.

Rice reminds voters that only the applicant can submit his or her own absentee ballot application. It is against the law to submit an absentee ballot application for another person.
