Additional Important Voter Information

Voter Registration Required:

A person who is at least 18 years old, a United States citizen, an Oklahoma resident, and a registered voter in this county is eligible to vote.

A convicted felon may not register for a period of time equal to the time of the original sentence. A convicted felon who has been pardoned may register.

An application for new voter registration or for a change of voter registration must be received by the County Election Board not later than the 25th day before an election in order for you to be eligible to vote in the election.

All registered voters, including elderly, disabled, minority, military, and overseas citizens have a right to equal access to the election system.

Election Day Transactions:

If you are the next-of-kin of a registered voter in this county who is deceased, you may fill out a Request to Cancel Registration of Deceased Voter form to have the person's name removed from the registration records. Ask one of the Precinct Officials to help you.

If you have moved but have not yet changed your address for voter registration, you may do so today. Tell one of the Precinct Officials that you need to change your address. Fill out the Oklahoma Voter Registration Application form, sign it, and return it to the Precinct Officials before you leave the polling place. You will receive a new voter identification card before the next election.
